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

Doing Business with the Government

- Must be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) PRIOR to proposal deadline: https://www.sam.gov/portal/SAM/
 - Create a login.gov account; must have a working phone number to receive a security code
 - Will need:
 - DUNS Number, Legal Business Name, Physical Address from your Dun & Bradstreet (D&B) record
 - Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) and Taxpayer Name
 - Bank's routing number, bank account number, and bank account type, i.e. checking or savings, to set up Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT)

<u>Security</u>



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


