SUBJECT: **Pro-Gear: An Important Reminder for the Packing Crew**

Recently, the government has clarified the regulations on Pro-Gear entitlements for Military Customers.

The Pro-Gear must be separated by the customer and packed in boxes with its contents listed on the inventory. No longer is just the word 'progear' allowed; the actual contents, such as flight jacket or reference material **must be listed** along with the weight.

Example: 4.5 ctn – flight jacket – Pro-Gear – 31.5# Constructive  
1.5 ctn – reference material – Pro-Gear – 10.5# Bathroom Scale

(The constructive weight above was figured using 7# per cubic foot and the bathroom scale was used and annotated as such. Under normal circumstances, one method would be used.)

The spouse is also allowed 500# of Pro-Gear **if** their profession has been annotated on the 1299. The spouse's Pro-Gear must be listed on **its own inventory sheet** and described the same as above.

*Since the local agent is normally packing the military shipment, we are asking the agent to have the Pro-Gear inventory prepared and also list the Pro-Gear weight on the 619 for the Military Customer to sign.*
